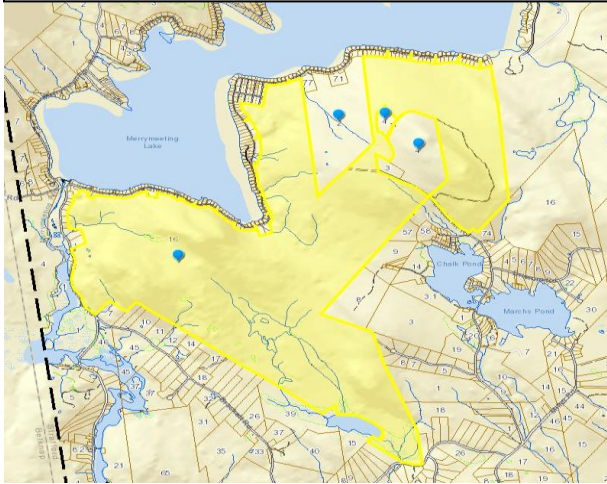
Strength in Numbers!
