Water Quality Testing



- Once a week ideally April to October
- Ideal team size, 3-4 people
- 3 collection sites, lab prep work
 - approximately 2 hrs/week





What is needed:

- Lead organizer, communicator, scheduler (or 2)
 - can be done remotely, via email or text 5 mins/wk
- Collectors can be weekly, monthly, once a year
 - As long as we can get 3-4 each trip
 - Current pool of volunteers 7, and shrinking

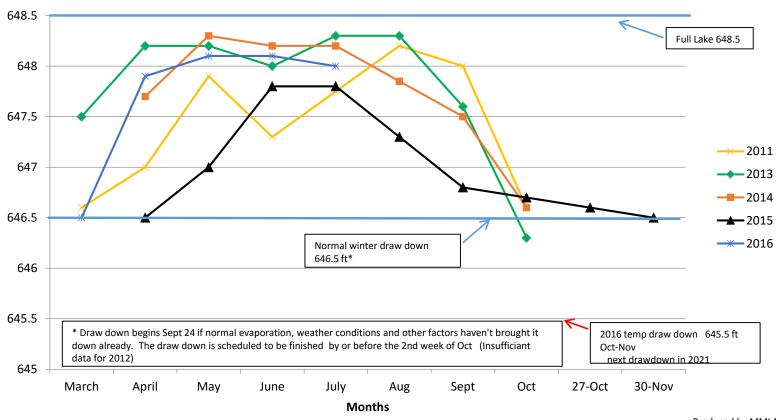
Through public education and with the assistance of local residents, state agencies, and private contractors; the committee will identify sites of infestation, develop best management plans to control plant growth and spread to adjacent waterways, seek public and private sources of funding to implement the plan (including post treatment monitoring), and educate users of water recreational vehicles on the necessity to remove any suspicious plants before introducing their vehicles into New Durham waterbodies.
